- Who:** Anyone interested in Camp Fire Summer Camp programs  
*Parents, volunteers, leaders, alumni, groups, everyone is urged to get involved*
- When:** Starting at Noon Saturday, March 20, through Sunday, March 21
- Where:** Camp Cimarron, Oklahoma  
*From I-35 near Guthrie, take exit #157 to Hwy 33 East, 12 miles;  
Cross Cimarron River and immediately turn right on E0720 Road.*
- How:** Pre-register with Camp Fire Heart of Oklahoma main office,

*All youth must be accompanied by at least one parent per family*
- Why:** To study and plan for camp rehabilitation and potential re-opening  
*All adults should join at least one brainstorming group meeting*
- Groups:** Camp Fire Groups can camp together, *but parents must attend*
- Facilities:** Plan for "wilderness" or "primitive" camping  
*Camp facilities (bathrooms, etc.) may be limited or unavailable*  
*Only certain areas of camp will be open; parts of camp will be "off limits"*
- Fees:** None for Camp Fire members; non-members are asked to join or donate
